PREPARE FOR YOUR VISIT

Whether you are visiting a permanent Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) facility or a one-day collection event, please follow these easy steps to make your experience safe, easy and efficient.

- **Proof of residency is required** please bring a driver's license, tax bill, etc.
- Make sure containers are tightly sealed and properly secured in your vehicle. Consider bringing your items in a recyclable container, such as a cardboard box.
- Please stay in your car. To ensure participants safety, it is recommended that you remain in your vehicle.
- Bring material in original, sealed containers with labels intact and readable.
- Avoid mixing different products which could cause explosive or poisonous chemical reactions.
- Individual container sizes cannot exceed 5 gallons.
- No materials from commercial establishments will be accepted. No commercial vehicles will be unloaded.
- Some counties have a <u>maximum quantity</u> of household hazardous waste that is accepted. Please check with your individual county.
- Some permanent HHW facilities require registration, so consult your county before you go.
- These are general guidelines to assist in preparing to visit a HHW program. Residents are encouraged to check their County website to review specific guidelines beforehand.
